

Basic Rules for Mrs. Foodrite Get going Women's Premier League Cum Knockout Cricket Matches

LEAGUE MATCHES

1. Every match will be of 5 overs
2. Every team has 8 players, 7 adults and 1 kid. (*Age limit girl child 8yrs-14yrs, male child 8yrs – 12yrs)
3. There are 4 pools in league matches A,B,C,D subject to the number of teams registered.
4. Only overarm bowling without run up . No direct throw is allowed. Arm has to be rotated behind the shoulder and released.
5. If a bowler bowls 3 consecutive dead balls the Umpire will take appropriate decision to change the bowler of the same capability. The 6th and 7th player who has not bowled will be given preference. In this umpire's decision will be final.
6. **RUNS-**
 - A) 1 single run by running across in each over is compulsory. If mid pitch by the batsman is completed by running, even if the ball touches the net. Run will be counted.
 - B) If the ball touches the side net before the half line is declared 1 run and after the half line is declared 2 runs.
 - C) 4 runs- if the ball bounces and touches the front net below the 10ft mark .
 - D) 6 runs- If the ball touches the front net below the 10ft mark without bounce
 - E) If ball touches front net above the 10ft mark it is declared OUT
 - F) if the ball touches the upper net only running between the wicket is counted. NO 4 RUNS, NO 6 RUNS, NO CATCH OUT.
 - G) In every match, the child will come in order of 2 Down
 - H) if the ball touches the roof net and then hits the side net, declared runs are not considered. Runs taken between the wickets are considered.
 - I) if the ball touches the front net above 10feet after touching the roof, IT IS NOT OUT.
 - J) One run and free hit will be given on NO BALL.
 7. Wide ball, No ball, dead ball, taking a Run on Overthrow is allowed. A ball above the waist height will be considered No ball. Players will get a free hit on No ball. ONLY RUN OUT IS CONSIDERED.
 8. A BALL WITH MORE THAN 1 Bounce IS CONSIDERED Dead.
One strike rotation is compulsory at every over. If not followed the batsman on strike will be declared out.
 9. Every team must finish all overs in 25 minutes. If not, the batting team will be given 10 extra runs. The umpire's decision will be final.

SPECIAL SITUATION

- 10. Each winning team will be given 2 points. In case of the same points in the same pool the average score will be considered. The team with the highest average score will be announced as the Top team.**
 - 11. In case of tie a SUPER OVER will be played. (*Applicable only in Knockouts)**
 - 12. If a bowler bowls 3 consecutive dead balls the Umpire will take appropriate decision to change the bowler. The umpire's decision will be final.**
13. Knock Out match will be of 7 overs
 - 13 Every player in team will have to bowl one over in each knock out match.
 - 14 To play in the knock out match, the player should play in one of the league matches.

OUT RULES

- Direct Catch
- Stumping
- Hit Wicket
- Run out
- If ball touches above the 10 feet mark on the front net.

SUBSTITUTE PLAYER

- In case of player's non availability in team, Injury or retired hurt the Get Going organizing team will not provide substitute player.
- If a team does not report in given time, the umpire will take appropriate decision at that time.
- Final rights of decision are reserved with the organizing committee of Get going Team.
- Declared runs will be explained by the Umpire.
- The winning team will be awarded the Winner's Trophy and Gold medals to all players.
- The runner-up team will be awarded the Runner-up trophy and silver medals to all players.
- Promising and outstanding players in each team will be awarded with surprise Gifts.
- Special trophies for women of the series, Best batsman, best Bowler and Best Fielder will be awarded.
- Each participant of Mrs. Foodrite Get going Women's Premier League would be awarded a medal and certificate of participation.
